Scholarship Program awarded \$1million+

- ✓ To promote excellence in transportation, MSES sponsors the largest civil engineering scholarship program in Minnesota. Since 1953, MSES has helped **over 900 students totaling over one million dollars in scholarships!**
- ✓ Recipients are civil engineering or land surveying under-graduates from Minnesota with financial need, a sound academic record, and a strong interest in the transportation field.
- ✓ **Three** fellowships at the U/M have been awarded to those who qualify as graduate students focused in bituminous study.

- ✓ Between \$30-\$50,000 in scholarships are given annually to CE students at the University of MN, North Dakota State University, MN State University- Mankato, land surveying students at Saint Cloud State University and, since 2003, “at-large” CE scholarships to students attending nine schools in the north central region.

The Scholarship Trust Fund grows through individual and corporate donations, memorials, and earnings.
